RECEPTION

The first Monday morning of each week, the animation team will be happy to welcome you at 8:00 am. Morning and evening reception is at the upper part section of the Centre, in the parking lot near the big top. Camp schedule is from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

ATTENDANCE TAKING POLICY

1. At daycare, attendance is monitored at the daycare reception area;
2. On the bus, attendance is monitored by the monitor in charge;
3. At the assembly, the monitor checks the attendance of children in his group;
4. The monitors take attendance regularly during the day;

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On excursions, the same procedures apply, but the attendance is taken more frequently.

Note: Centre Notre-Dame-de-Fatima day camp takes control of children as they arrive on site, at daycare or on the bus, but it is not responsible for children who walk, ride their bicycle or wait for the bus alone.

TIPS FOR THE LUNCH BOX

It is important to preserve the foods in lunch boxes. The CNDF day camp is not able to provide a refrigerated area for the lunch boxes. Here are some tips to keep your child's lunch cool and fresh all day:

- Place one or two Ice Pack in the lunch. It will keep food cold for 4 to 6 hours.
- Add a frozen juice box. It will keep the food fresher even longer.
- For salads and dairy produce, use an insulated container (« thermos ») that was previously cooled.

Monitors will make sure that backpacks and lunch boxes will be in the shades during the day.

ADDITIONS/MODIFICATIONS

No limits for registration, modifications or additions.

In case of cancellation before provision of service, a file management fee of \$20 per child per week will be retained. No refunds after the beginning of service. In case of sickness or accident, lost days will be reimburse "prorata" (doctor's paper mandatory).
