

Overview of measures related to COVID-19

2021 Summer – Centre Notre-Dame-de-Fatima



This document briefly presents an overview of measures put in place by our team for 2021 day camp. These measures are based on 4 indicators given by the Association des camps du Québec and the Public Health General Management.

<p>Physical distancing</p> 	<p>You will need to go to the reception desk identified in your child's program:</p> <p><u>Gazebo / big top section:</u> Touche-à-Tout programs, all ages. <u>Section in the park</u> (to the left of the pool at the back): Bout-de-Choux, Jr. Outdoor, Outdoor and specialized programs.</p> <p>Remember to keep a distance of 2 meters from other people at all times. It is strongly recommended for adults to wear a face cover at all times when arriving and departing at the day camp, even if we are outside as it can be complex to respect the distance while waiting.</p> <p>The daycare service was thought differently to lower the number of children present in the same zone. There is no more distancing between children of the same group.</p>
<p>Outdoor activities</p> 	<p>All day long, the camp will be outside, even during lunch time.</p> <p>In case of bad weather, a local will be assigned for each group, while maintaining sanitary measures and physical distancing.</p> <p>Procedures for the swimming pool have been revised to respect sanitary measures recommended by Public Health.</p>
<p>Limitating physical contacts</p> 	<p>Specialized activity areas have been reimaged to ensure activities with the less contact possible.</p> <p>Many activities without contact have been created by our animation team.</p>
<p>Hygiene measures</p> 	<p>Wearing a mask, inside or outside, is no longer required for children since we are now in a green zone.</p> <p>Monitors and employees of the Center will wear adequate individual protection equipment when needed according to the CNESST rules.</p> <p>Washing hands is mandatory at the arrival at camp and many times during the day (snack time, lunch, bathroom, activities, etc.).</p> <p>Sanitary stations were added all over the site allowing disinfection of material and surfaces by the monitors after each activity.</p>
