Overview of measures related to COVID-19

2022 Summer - Chêne-Bleu day camp (operated by Centre Notre-Dame-de-Fatima)



This document briefly presents an overview of measures put in place by our team for 2022 day camp. These measures are based on 4 indicators given by the Association des camps du Québec and the Public Health General Management.

Physical distancing	Arrivals and departures will be at the side door where is the access of the library. Do not use the main school door. Remember to keep a distance of 2 meters from other people at all times. It is strongly recommended for adults to wear a face cover at all times when arriving and departing at the day camp, even if we are outside as it can be complex to respect the distance while waiting.
	The daycare service was thought differently to lower the number of children present in the same zone. There is no more distancing between children of the same group.
Outdoor activities	All day long, the camp will be outside, even during lunch time. In case of bad weather, a local will be assigned for each group, while maintaining sanitary measures and physical distancing. Procedures for the swimming pool have been revised to respect sanitary measures recommended by Public Health.
Limitating physical contacts	Activity areas have been reimagined to ensure activities with the less contact possible between groups. Many activities without contact have been created by our animation team.
Hygiene measures	Wearing a mask, inside or outside, is no longer required for children since we are now in a green zone. Monitors and employees of the Center will wear adequate individual protection equipment when needed according to the CNESST rules. Washing hands is mandatory at the arrival at camp and many times during the day (snack time, lunch, bathroom, activities, etc.).
