



Camper life code

The **camper life code** has as an objective to supervise the life at camp of all the campers in order to maintain a safe and stable environment in which the child will be able to develop and feel comfortable.

1. Rules

The camper agrees to :

- Have fun while being respectful and safe.
- Participate in the activities with enthusiasm and a good mood.
- Respect the instructions provided by the responsible adults.
- Use a polite and appropriate language with campers and employees.
- Be able to resolve conflicts without using violence.
- Take care of the equipment, material, and halls.
- Respect nature and the environment.
- Wear appropriate and decent clothing to the Centre activities.
- Leave at home video games, cellular phones, and tablets.

2. Procedures in case rules are not respected

If the Camper life code is not respected, depending on the severity of the situation and if there is repetition, the following measures will be applied:

- The camper is advised verbally by the monitor. The parent is advised verbally at the end of the day by a Centre employee.
- The child is temporarily removed from the activities. The parent is advised verbally at the end of the day by a Centre employee.
- The child is suspended for one day. The parent is advised verbally by the Camp Manager. Both a verbal and written notice will be given to the parent advising them that if it happens again, the child will be expelled. There is not reimbursement for the day of suspension.
- The child is excluded from all camps offered at Plein Air Fatima Centre for the summer. The coordinator advises the parent both verbally and in written. In this case, the reimbursement will be based on the non-used days (registration fees and used days are not refundable).
- A child that unable to participate in the camp activities while respecting the above-mentioned rules could therefore be expelled, in the best interests of both the camp and the camper.
